

How It Works

When the conductors and the interface are in place within the connector, the Shear Bolt can then be tightened using any hex head wrench, ratchet, or speed socket. When 12.5 ft. pounds of torgue is applied to the drive bolt, the hex head shears off. This process drives the wedge into the connector and creates approximately 3,000 lbs of connecting force on the conductors. The force that has been introduced into the connector causes a .015" deflection of the "C" member. At this point, a spring has been created that maintains a constant and consistent connecting force on the conductors.


